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1. Purpose of this Privacy Notice

Privacy Notice is a statement of us (data controller) to you (data subject) that describes how we collect, use, retain and disclose personal data.

3. Data subjects

For us, you as a data subject may be a Visitor, User, and Crypto Holder.

Visitor	Everyone who visits our website, Telegram, Social media
User	Visitors who fill out our forms
Crypto Holder	Users who exchange cryptocurrencies

4. Personal data we process

We process three types of personal data:

- technical information;
- data provided by Users and Crypto Holders;
- data obtained from third parties.

Pay your attention. We **do not** knowingly **process** Users' personal data which is under 18 without consent from a legal representative(s).

Only technical information.	We can collect: email.	We receive: personal wallets addresses, amount and type of cryptocurrency exchanges, amount of WTR.

Technical information. When you visit our website, some data is collected automatically. We need technical data to operate, maintain, and improve our website. This includes data such as IP address, cookies (including third-party cookies), geolocation, UTM parameters, MAC, name of your internet service provider, browser type, device type, and data about your interaction with the website – session ID.

The **session ID** includes your interaction with the website, the functions you use, the pages viewed on our website, the way you use our website, and the actions you take if such actions are present.

Data obtained from third parties. Data that we can get from third resources such as:

- [Telegram](#) (Full Name, photo, phone number, information about yourself, the information you can provide if you interact with our group.)

5. Sharing data with third parties

We use your personal data to perform a contract and for communication between you and us. We use and transfer your personal data in measures that are needed to perform a contract.

Also, we transfer your data on the following grounds:

Consent	We may transfer your personal data based on your explicit consent
Compliance with law	<p>We will disclose your personal data to third parties to the extent that it is necessary:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> to comply with a government request, court order, or applicable law; to prevent unlawful use of our website or violation of the Terms of Use of our website and our policies; to protect against claims of third parties; to help prevent or investigate fraud.
Legitimate interest or performance of the contract	We may transfer your personal data to third parties based on a public offer for processing on our behalf, subject to technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data. We may transfer your

	personal data to certain companies, consultants, and contractors hired to provide certain services on our behalf
We will ask your consent if data transfer is not part of the contract	

6. Period of data storage

We store **User data** during the use of our services and for 3 years afterward.

We store **technical data (Visitor data)** for up to 2 years.

You can exercise your right to delete your data. In this case, your data will be deleted from our servers within 30 days of your request.

Note: the data concerning your crypto transactions is stored and can't be deleted due to the nature of the blockchain.

The length of time we can retain **data from third parties** is determined by Telegram's [Privacy Policy](#).

7. Data transfer outside the European Economic Area

The personal data we collect is stored on our servers in Estonia. By default, the data is processed in Estonia, but we may need to process your personal data in another country.

8. Your privacy rights

You, as subjects of personal data, have the following rights:

The right to access information	You can request an explanation of the processing of your personal data
The right to portability	You can request all the data that you provided to us, as well as request to transfer data to another controller
The right to restrict processing	You may partially or completely prohibit us from processing your personal data
The right to be forgotten	You can send us a request to delete your personal data from our systems unless there is a legal requirement to keep it

The right to file complaints	If we do not satisfy your request — you can file a complaint to the regulatory body
The right to withdraw consent	You may leave consent to some data processing. If you want to withdraw any of your consents you can do it anytime
